LIVER BISCUITS

Ingredients

- 1 lb. chicken livers
- 1 cup wheat flour
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp. garlic powder
- 1 cup flour
- 3 cups corn meal

Directions:

Blend livers, eggs, flour and garlic powder in a food processor. Scrape into large bowl and add corn meal. Mix. Dough will be stiff. Spread on a large baking sheet. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes. Slice when warm (pizza cutter works great). Store in freezer

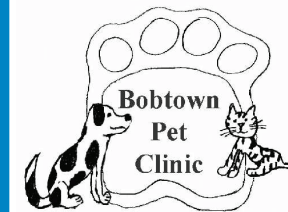
If you have friends or neighbors who might like to receive our newsletter, they may also sign up to join our email community by contacting us or through the link.
