### Fleas, Ticks and Mosquitoes

These pesky parasites cause many problems for our pets. The late summer and early fall months are prime time in our geographic area for these pests. Fleas and mosquitoes have been increasing in numbers throughout the summer. Ticks are very active and looking for hosts before winter. Mosquitoes have had warm weather long enough that heartworms can readily be transmitted to a new host.

Make sure to continue to use heartworm preventatives and flea and tick products at least until the snow flies in earnest. This will help protect your pet from diseases caused and spread by these parasites.

## PEAMUTT BUTTER BONES

2 Tbs corn oil  
½ cup peanut butter  
1 cup water  
1 cup whole wheat flour  
2 cups white flour

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Combine oil, peanut butter, and water. Add flour one cup at a time, and then knead into firm dough. Roll dough to ¼ inch thick and cut with cookie cutter. Place on an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake for 20mins. Makes 2 ½ dozen.
